A scoop bucket could be helpful if the job requires transferring gravel, snow, sand, or soil. A double block handler allows the forklift operator to pick up a couple of loads and after that pile them side-by-side. One more forklift attachment is the package lift clamp, that can lift and transfer heavier pallets. Also, pallet crane forks may be utilized to lift and move pallets with an overhead crane.
